



Queen Anne's County Arts Council Scholarship Applicant Requirements

1. Eligible students are those who plan to major in one of the following arts programs at the college or university level: **Visual Arts, Music, Drama, Dance or Writing (poetry, plays, short stories)**.
2. To apply, complete the Scholarship Application.
3. Include a teacher's letter of recommendation for appropriate fine arts discipline for which you are applying.
4. Submit a detailed statement of your recent **accomplishments** and **achievements** and **why** you wish to pursue an education in the arts.
5. Fulfill the requirements, as listed below, appropriate to the Fine Arts discipline for which you are applying:
 - a) **VISUAL ARTS:** a portfolio containing a minimum of six (6) of your artworks;
 - b) **MUSIC:** be prepared to perform a six-minute audition (vocal; an art song and contrasting selection; instrumental; a composition for solo instrument);
 - c) **DANCE:** be prepared to audition in basic techniques and follow with a two (2) minute routine;
 - d) **DRAMA:** be prepared to perform a five to six-minute audition.
 - e) **WRITING:** a portfolio containing a minimum of six of your poems, or two plays, or four short stories.
6. Finalists will be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee to discuss your portfolio or presentation.
7. Completed applications must be received by **April 30th**. Applications received after this date will not be considered.

SELECTION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

The recipients of the scholarships will be determined by an independent Scholarship Committee selected by the Arts Council Board of Directors. Incomplete applications will not be considered. AWARD ANNOUNCEMENT

Scholarship recipients **must be enrolled as full-time students** in a college, or with a recognized institution for advanced education in the specified discipline, for the fall semester, following secondary school graduation. The scholarship money will be forwarded to the designated college or university's Registrar's Office by the Arts Council in August.
